Fenestration Performance: Cold Compliance and Alternatives

This session will cover changes to building and energy codes that Alberta will adopt in 2019. In addition, we will look at the increasing desire for designers and contractors to use more performance based alternatives to prescriptive compliance in these codes. Finally, future code direction and objectives will be covered to solidify the ideas that performance objectives for the fenestration component are long term realities of building codes, and that whole building solutions and component performance dependencies are likely to be the most cost effective solutions in future buildings.
